Department recently got permission to start MD course in PMR with an intake of 2 seats per year from academic session 2022-23 affiliated to University of Delhi.

We have started taking regular classes of undergraduate students from the year 2021. Inclusion of disability competencies in foundation course of Competency based medical education will prove very useful for the students as they will learn the skills & attributes essential to provide quality health care to patients with disabilities.
